ABOUT THE BOUNDARY PROCESS

To maximize instructional opportunities for all students, new school attendance boundaries are being proposed in 2015-16. This follows an intensive year-long review by an ad hoc stakeholders group known as the **Attendance Boundary Committee (ABC)**.

The ABC committee has considered population growth, balancing existing capacity with demand, and investing in classroom technology, in its recommendations to realign some, but not all, elementary, K8, and middle school attendance boundaries.

Questions and answers about the proposed boundary changes, impacts, timelines, maps, and informational resources are on succeeding slides.

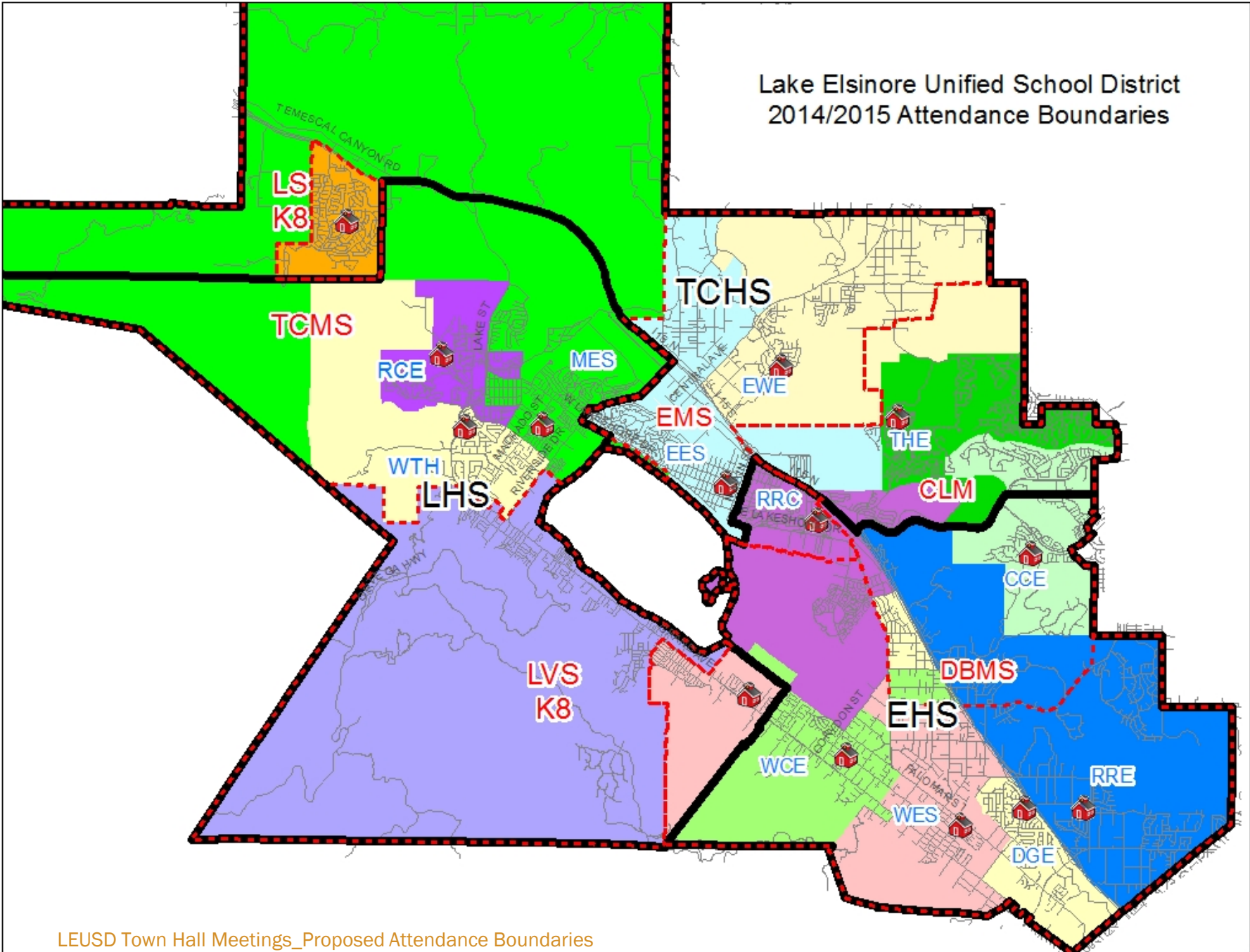


GOALS OF THE ABC COMMITTEE

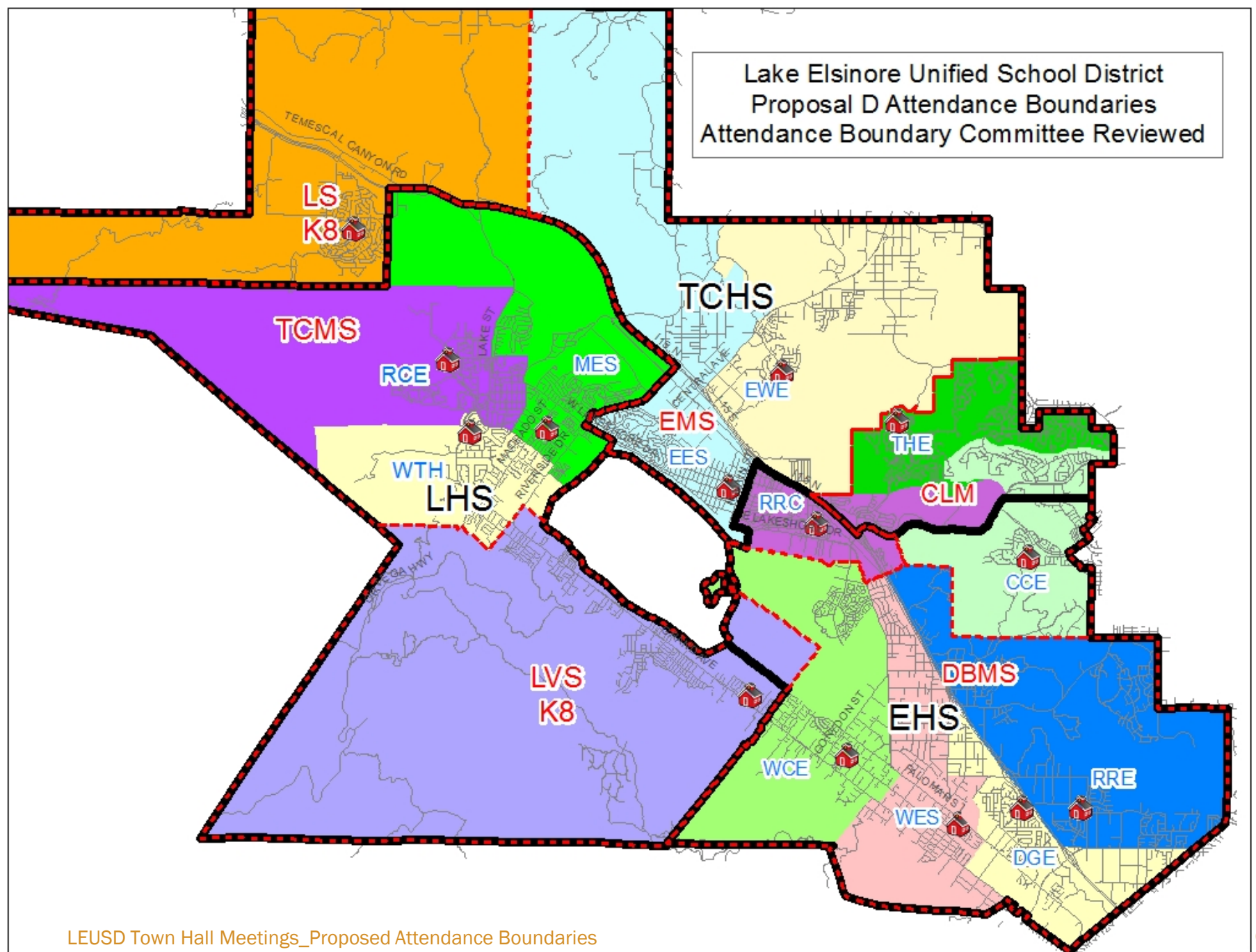
1. Focus on Student Needs for a “best in class” 21st Century Education:
