Royal Time in a Nutshell

- Royal Time is an intervention period
- Purpose of serving all students' academic needs.
- Provide struggling students with time for support that they currently do not have, in a structured environment.
- Higher achieving students will have time to meet with teachers, mentor struggling students, or collaborate with their peers.

Royal Time Student Options

1. Mandatory Tutorial
2. Mandatory Homework Time
3. Freshman Link Crew
4. Self Directed Study Time
5. Tutorial Mentors

Mandatory Tutorial

Who is enrolled: Students who received a D or F the previous term and are currently enrolled in that same subject.

Students can be referred by a current teacher needing extra support.

Students in grades 11 & 12 who have not passed the CAHSEE

Once in a Tutorial, students stay until the end of the current Term

Attendance will be taken.

Homework Time

Who is enrolled: Students who received a D or F the previous term and are no longer enrolled in that same subject.

Once in Homework Time, students stay until the end of the current term.

Attendance will be taken.



Self-Directed Study Time

Who is enrolled: Students who received grades A-C during the previous term.

Students earn the privilege of self-directed study time; can be moved to Tutorial based on their current class performance.

Opportunity to meet with teachers, complete assignments, study individually or in groups, AP review sessions or extended lunch.

Closed Campus with supervision.



Freshman Link Crew



Who is enrolled: All Freshman students for all of Term 1.

Two days per week on culture/team building activities and two days per week on academic support.

After the Term 1 grading cycle ends, students will transition to Mandatory Tutorial, Homework Time or Self-Directed Study Time as determined by their grades.

Attendance will be taken.

Academic Mentors

Who is enrolled: Students with grades A-C can choose this option instead of Self-Directed Study Time.

Assigned to a Mandatory Tutorial or Homework Time classroom.

Enrolled in a class: can receive a grade or community service hours (not both).

Attendance will be taken.

**** Will have designated days to meet with own teachers. ****

Link Crew Leaders

Who is enrolled: Students with grades A-C and are in grades 11 & 12 can choose this option instead of Self-Directed Study Time.

Assigned to a Freshman Link Crew classroom.

Enrolled in a class: can receive a grade or community service hours (not both).

Terms 2-4: Can serve as Academic Mentor.

Attendance will be taken.

We are Recruiting Mentors

Work with students who need your help.

Research shows mentoring other students increases achievement for both mentor and mentee.

Not a TA position – will not be grading, photocopying, etc.

Opportunity to develop a personalized relationship with a teacher – great for letters of Rec.
