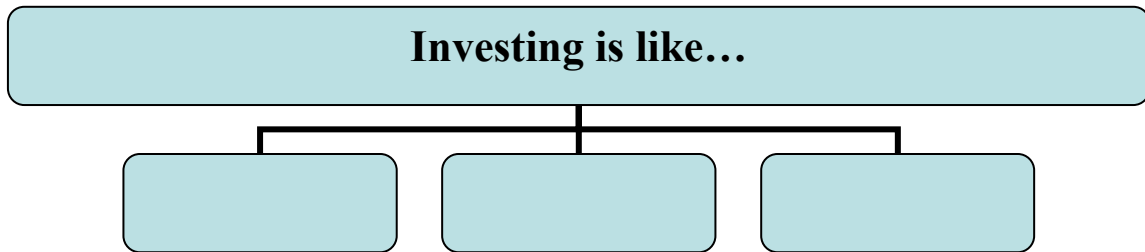

Investment Analogies
