English 9, English 10, English 11, English 12, Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Biology, Finite Math, Biology, Chemistry, Physical Science, Economics, Personal Finance, US Government, US History, World History & Geography

\*All students must follow CS policies and procedures. Failure to do so could result in dismissal from summer school. Students enrolled in seated courses with an End of Course test, (Algebra I and Algebra II), must take the state-mandated exam. These tests will count 25% of the final grade. Dates to be determined by the State.

\*\*Credit recovery coursework is only allowed for students who have failed the course. Please see your child's counselor if you have any questions.
