Bus Issues

We would like to remind all parents to be at your bus stops 7 minutes before bus pick up time and allow 5 minutes after pick up time in case the bus is running late. If the bus driver does not see students outside at their bus stops, they will continue on to the next. We have received several reports that the bus has not been picking up children and several reports from the bus company stating that children are not at their bus stops.

Please have children out on time, and if bus has not arrived within 5 minutes of pick-up, call the bus company at (651) 633-3159. The school must still be notified if there are any issues with the bus company.
