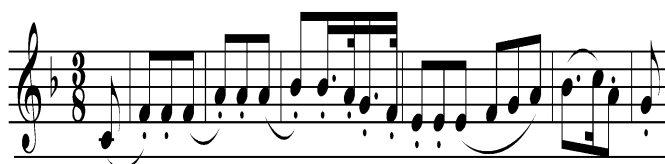

PROJECT SENSORY

Project Sensory is a project that is focused on helping students with Autism. This project includes students, teachers, and community members in a combined effort to build and develop a secondary level sensory lab.

What is a Sensory Lab you ask? A Sensory Lab is a place Autistic students can go to self-calm or self-regulate behaviors. Autistic students struggle with something called stemming and need a calming or at times a stimulating environment. A sensory lab provides this for them. A campus based Sensory Lab may contain various motor lab equipment such as swing, treadmill, recumbent bike, and other workout equipment. As well as bean bag chairs, sensory lighting, sit-n-spin, bubble tubes, scene projection, and calming music.

Currently we have close to twenty students at the high school that would benefit. In the future, we could have as many as 25-30 students who would need the advantages of this room. For the district, this room could potentially help over 150 or more students with Autism.
