Hemet, February 24, 2015: Volunteer opportunities to be a part of the Hemet Unified School District Proposition 39 Citizens' Oversight Committee for Measures T and U are available! This committee, which is made up of taxpayers, directly participates in the oversight of bond expenditures ensuring that the expenditures are in strict conformity with the law. Due to term expirations and retirement the District is seeking applicants to fill vacant positions and alternate positions on the committee.

Applicants are needed in each of the following five categories:

- Active in a business organization representing the business community located within the District;
- II. Active in a senior citizens' organization;
- III. Active in a bona fide taxpayer association;
- IV. Parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District;
- V. Both a parent or guardian of a child enrolled in the District <u>and</u> active in a parent teacher organization, such as the Parent Teacher Association or School Site Council.
