



Sage Hill stays unbeaten in Academy League

Sage Hill took a big step toward capturing the Academy League baseball title with a 6-5 victory over Crean Lutheran on Tuesday at Crean Lutheran High.

The Lightning is 9-0 in league with three league games remaining, while the Saints dropped to 5-2 in league. The teams meet again Friday at Sage Hill.

Parker Reposa had three hits for Sage Hill (14-6 overall), which is ranked No. 4 in CIF-SS Division 6 while Crean Lutheran (16-8 overall) is ranked No. 1.

Brett Super pitched the first six innings to earn his seventh win of the season, and **Kellen Ochii** pitched the seventh to earn the save.

Crean Lutheran had the bases loaded with one out in the seventh, but the Lightning got the final two outs - on a force out at the plate and a strikeout - to escape with the victory.

In the Garden Grove League:

Garden Grove 6, La Quinta 2: Senior **Beto Vazquez** pitched a four-hitter with five strikeouts and hit a home run to help the Argonauts (11-8, 8-2) take sole possession of first place by defeating the visiting Aztecs (12-8, 7-3).

Vazquez finished 3 for 4, including a double, with three RBI and three runs.

Garden Grove and La Quinta will play again Friday at Garden Grove.

Rancho Alamitos 17, Los Amigos 1: **Rudy Conriquez** went 2 for 4 with 6 RBI and **Shane Zielinski** contributed four two doubles and four RBI in the lopsided victory for the Vaqueros (14-6, 7-3).

In the Pacific Coast League:

Corona del Mar 12, University 1: **Evan Larsen** scattered four hits over six innings, **Brenden Hueston** went 2 for 3 with two RBI and **Nick Premer** added three RBI for the Seas Kings (14-6, 6-3).

In the Trinity League:

Mater Dei 7, No. 5 Orange Lutheran 2: **Austin Reyes** went 3 for 3 with two RBI, and **Michael Thomas** pitched a four-hitter and did not allow an earned run for the Monarchs (13-9, 3-4), who moved into a four-way tie for third place in league.

Jimmy Daley and **Sam Cachola** each contributed two RBI for Mater Dei, which plays the Lancers (15-7, 3-4) two more times this week - Wednesday at Hart Park, Friday at Mater Dei.
