Bond package was developed through a long range planning committee with community and school collaboration toward:

- Improving the educational experience for every child in the district by touching every campus
- Creating safe, healthy, and interactive learning environments
- Reducing overhead operating costs through more energy efficient systems

Estimated Tax Impact of the Bond

Taxable Property Values	Estimated Additional Tax/Month
75,000	25.63
100,000	34.17
150,000	51.25

Home owners who have qualified for and received the "Over 65 Homestead Exemption" will not see a tax increase as a result of the proposed bond program.

How much will the bond cost?

\$63 million for designing, constructing, renovating, and equipping school facilities for PISD.

How this bond will benefit PISD and its students:



1. New Elementary School Campus Grades 2 – 5

- Relocate from outdated building and reduce overcrowding
- New Classrooms with technology, arts, and interactive science labs
- Outdoor learning environments, physical education, media center, and access to district facilities



2. High School Renovations

- Focus on career/tech programs including oil/gas industry, construction/welding, agricultural sciences, business, technology, and health and human services
- Classroom and corridor renovations to improve lighting, electrical, technology, and the overall function of the instructional setting
- Renovation of all restroom facilities



3. Primary School Addition (Pre K – 1)

- New classroom wing to accommodate needs
- New restrooms to meet needs
- Covered walkways



4. Intermediate and Junior High Renovations including classrooms and corridors



5. Reduce operating costs through more efficient systems

- Lighting, heating and air conditioning
- Durable, low maintenance materials
- Roof repair



6. New safety features including a controlled entry at the High School, expanded security, and improved traffic flow patterns



7. New Agricultural Animal Facility
