**Registration form AND payment MUST BE** returned no later than April 30<sup>th</sup> to Ms. Graham in order to reserve your child's spot. **ALL classes will have a limited number of slots available. PLEASE reserve now. You MUST PAY at the time of enrollment.**

**Please remember no refunds will be given if you choose not attend.**

Keep in mind that you will need to choose alternates in case your first choice is full. **Returning your form EARLY along with payment will increase the chances of creating the schedule you desire.**

**If your child is recommended for academic assistance (remediation) he cannot take an enrichment course until he has completed or registered for the remediation course.**

**Students that have been recommended by their teachers for academic assistance will have priority in placement in Academic Assistance Courses.**

Students will be released for pick-up at noon. If not picked up by 12:10, students will be taken to aftercare. Pick-up information will be emailed along with your child's schedule.

AFTER CARE is available at a prorated cost for students that attend Bay Haven/North Bay Haven's Academic and Enrichment Classes (this prorated amount is just for the 3 week session): \$50 for the 1<sup>st</sup> child per week plus field trip cost, \$40 for siblings per week plus field trip cost- After care hours for summer school students: 12-6 p.m. and all day on Friday. ## ACADEMIC ASSISTANCE COURSES

**NOTE: Taking an academic assistance class over the summer WILL NOT take the place of retention if retention has been recommended for your child. However, a review of skills that your child may need help with will always be of great benefit and better prepare him/her for the next school year.**

Academic Assistance (remediation classes) for EXITING grades K-5: Please indicate Academic Assistance and current grade level on the on the CHOICE CHART when completing the application. We must have enough students to enroll in remediation in order for the class to 'make'.

### Getting Ready for Kindergarten...June and July Sessions

Help your upcoming kindergartener learn the necessary skills to be a successful. Skills will include the following: gross motor skills, fine motor skills, how to hold a pencil correctly, story time, and many others in order to help your child begin school with a head start. Kindergarten students that will be attending Bay Haven or North Bay Haven will have priority. If space allows, then students attending other schools will be registered for this class.

### Games Galore (current 2<sup>nd</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> graders)... June and July Sessions

Card games, board games, computer games, smart board games, outside games, make a game...GAMES GALORE!!! We will have fun while playing some tried and true games as well as some new! Your child will learn cooperation and sportsmanship through the classic art of playing games!

### Read It...Make It...Take It... June and July Sessions

Come join the fun as we visit books by Eric Carle, Jan Brett, and Dr. Seuss. Crafts---Cooking---and LOTS OF FUN!!! \$10 fee payable to the teacher on the first day of class. For rising 1<sup>st</sup>-3<sup>rd</sup> graders

### Totally Terrific Technology-Kaci McMann...June ONLY

In this session, students will learn beginning keyboarding, basic word processing, and PowerPoint, along with discovering academic games. For rising 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> graders \*\*\*Email address required for students for keyboarding program\*\*\*

### Get Off the Couch!... June and July Sessions

Rising 1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> grade students will be able to participate in a wide variety of age appropriate and skill building activities designed to promote skill and fitness. Students will “RUN FOR FUN”. We will have creative relay games to keep the students active and focused. Students will also participate in several Backyard Games, such as 4-Square, Dodge Ball, Kickball, and Jump Rope. Students should dress in comfortable running clothes and tennis shoes. A water bottle is recommended.

### A Dr. Seuss Summer...July ONLY

Not only do Dr. Seuss’ stories make learning to read and reading to learn fun, they also spark imagination and empower children to “think out of the box”. This enrichment class is designed for rising 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade students. With a different Dr. Seuss book every day, students will read, write, create, and play in fun and interesting ways. \$10 supply fee

### Forensics-Bay Haven CSI: 4<sup>th</sup> grade and up... June and July Sessions

Come join us as we conduct real forensics lab experiments including fingerprinting analysis to physical evidence processing. If you enjoy looking for clues as you solve book mysteries, this is the class for you. Students will learn real deductive and inductive reasoning skills. They will meet leading local and state criminal investigators and receive hands on knowledge of CSI procedures. If you like to learn to be a young Sherlock Holmes or if you just want to take a class that involves science with solving fun-filled mysteries, then this class is for you! \$10 lab fee

### The Domestic Arts...July ONLY

Do you want to learn to sew, quilt, can, preserve, crochet, and other old-fashioned domestic skills? Then this class is for you! Come crochet pot holders, sew buttons, sew pillowcases, make strawberry jam, can salsa, make butter, rice krispy treats and more, and then take home ALL you create. \$20 fee for supplies payable to the teacher on the first day of class: For rising 4<sup>th</sup> graders and up.

### Ooey, Gooley, Science... June and July Sessions

Come get your hands dirty while we learn about Physical Science. We’ll discover the different phases of matter, how to make fossils, bounce bubbles, and explore the world of rocks and colors. This class is for those who LOVE to get messy! A \$10 supply fee will be collected on the first day of class. For rising 1<sup>st</sup> to rising 3rd graders

### Science Explorers... June and July Sessions

Have you ever made your own bubbling lava lamp? Have you ever used real science tools to look carefully at the ground inside the circle of a hula hoop to see what you’ll discover? This is a unit designed to give students an understanding of the culture and lifestyles of the Ancient Egyptian people. Students will learn about the many fascinating artifacts that have been unearthed in recent years. Students will have hands-on experience recreating many of these ancient treasures. ### History Fair Summer Workshop This class is from 8-12... June and July Sessions

Are you interested in getting a jump start on your History Fair project for the 2014-2015 school year? Sign up for the summer workshop that will do just that. This year's theme is Leadership and Legacies. The class is open to 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students seeking to get a head start and possibly finish their projects. All students are expected to work diligently in this class. This class is from 8-12. The student will not take another enrichment course. Students will get a snack and recess break.

### Gardening FUNDamentals...June Only

Get ready to DIG IN to some gardening fun! Students will engage in all aspects of gardening: weather, composting, soil properties, the water cycle, conservation, BUGS!, and much more! Daily, we will have hands-on experience planting and cultivating in our garden, but will also spend plenty of time in the cool a/c classroom. We will journal our garden's progress, use math for various garden related calculations, and use the scientific method almost daily. ### **Marvelous Math Grades 3-4**

Enrichment hands-on fun activities that will reinforce math skills in measurement, money, multiplication, and geometry...Students will create models, conduct math experiments and explore geometry through the use of literature and hands-on activities. \$5 supply fee

### **Human Body Exploration Grades 3-5**

Student will explore the digestive, respiratory, nervous, circulatory, muscular, and skeletal systems while conducting experiments and creating models. \$5 supply fee

### **American Doll Camp Grades 2-4**

Students will learn about historical events correlated with the American Girl Dolls while creating crafts and hands-on activities involving sewing, jewelry making, and scrapbooking. \$10 supply fee
