The Board believes that the evaluation of instructional programs and comprehensive educational planning go hand-in-hand. Both are essential if the schools are to progress in meeting their goals for students.

Further, it believes that program evaluations and educational planning should be foremost among the Board's responsibilities and that the Board can best discharge its responsibilities through:

1. Establishing and/or approving machinery for program evaluation and planning
2. Reviewing results of program evaluation and approving priorities established for overall improvement in the schools.
