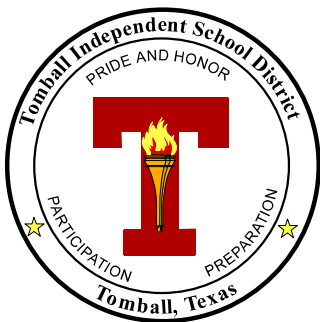

Tomball ISD's unofficial board election results

Unofficial results from Tuesday's election for four seats on the Tomball Independent School District Board of Trustees indicate that Kathy Handler was elected to Position 1, Michael Pratt was elected to Position 2, John McStravick was elected to Position 3, and Mark Lewandowski was elected to Position 4.

Handler, McStravick, and Lewandowski ran unopposed. Handler will fill the seat being vacated by Katherine Hanson, who announced her retirement after serving eight years as a trustee. McStravick has served as a trustee since 2000, and Lewandowski has served since 2003.

For the Position 2 seat, Pratt received 5,163 votes to David Zuhlke's 2,458 votes, and William Harris' 1,657 votes. Pratt will fill Stephen L. Robinson's seat following his retirement from the board. Robinson first served on the board of trustees from 2000-2003. He successfully ran again in 2005, and has served a total of eight years as a trustee.

Official results from Tuesday's election will be canvassed and announced during the Monday, Nov. 15 Board of Trustees workshop, which will begin at 5:30 p.m. at the Tomball ISD Boardroom, 221 W. Main Street. The elected candidates for Positions 1, 2, 3, and 4 will be sworn in to fulfill four year terms during the board workshop meeting.
