School Board Legal Status

The Board of Trustees of Sweetwater County School District No. 2 acts as the general agent of the state in carrying out the will of the people in matters pertaining to the public schools. Wyoming law established that the "board of trustees of a school district shall be the governing body of the school district..."

In accordance with the approved reorganization plan for the public schools in Sweetwater County, the Board of Trustees of Sweetwater County School District No. 2 consists of seven persons. A regular term of office is four years.
