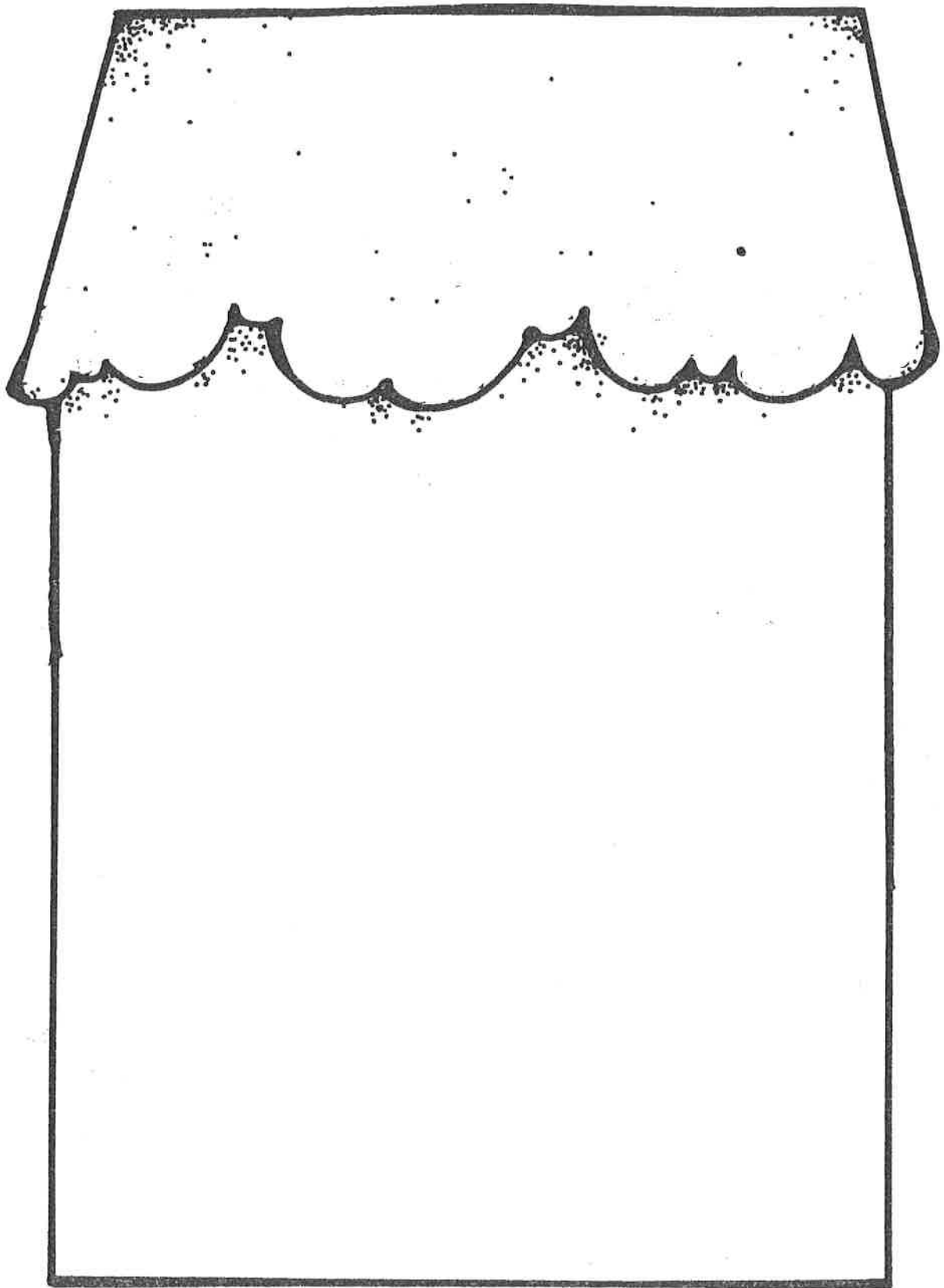

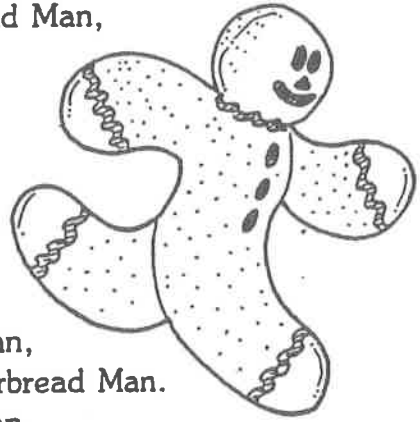
The Gingerbread Man

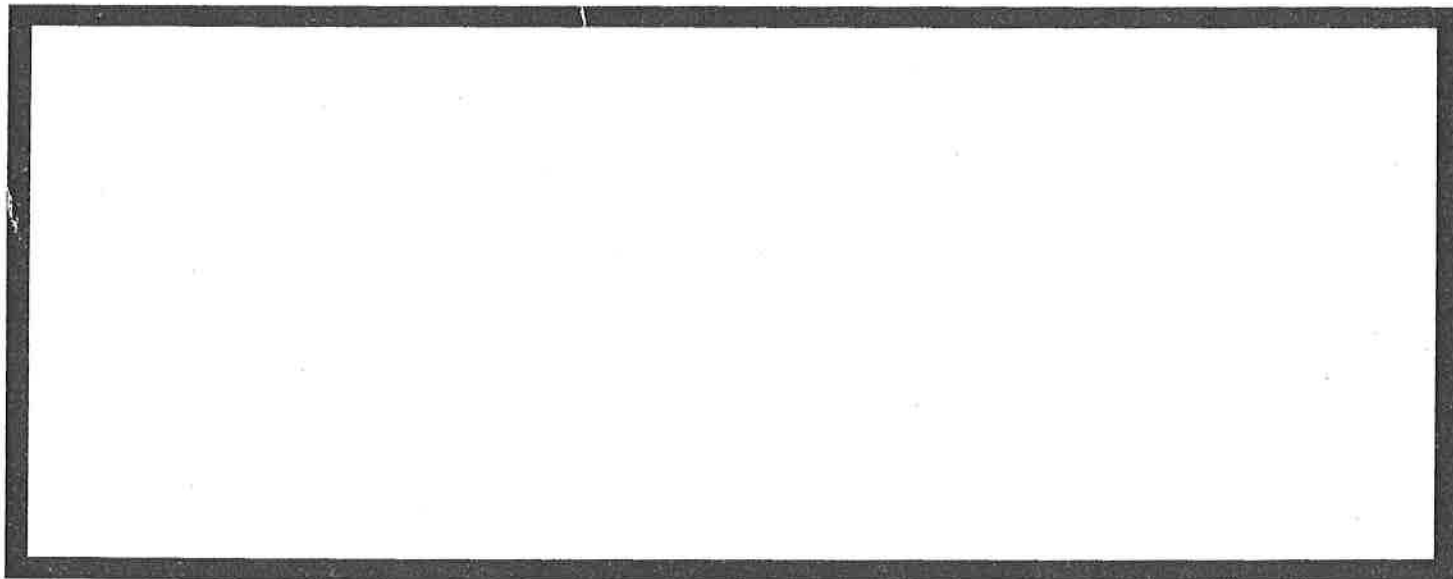

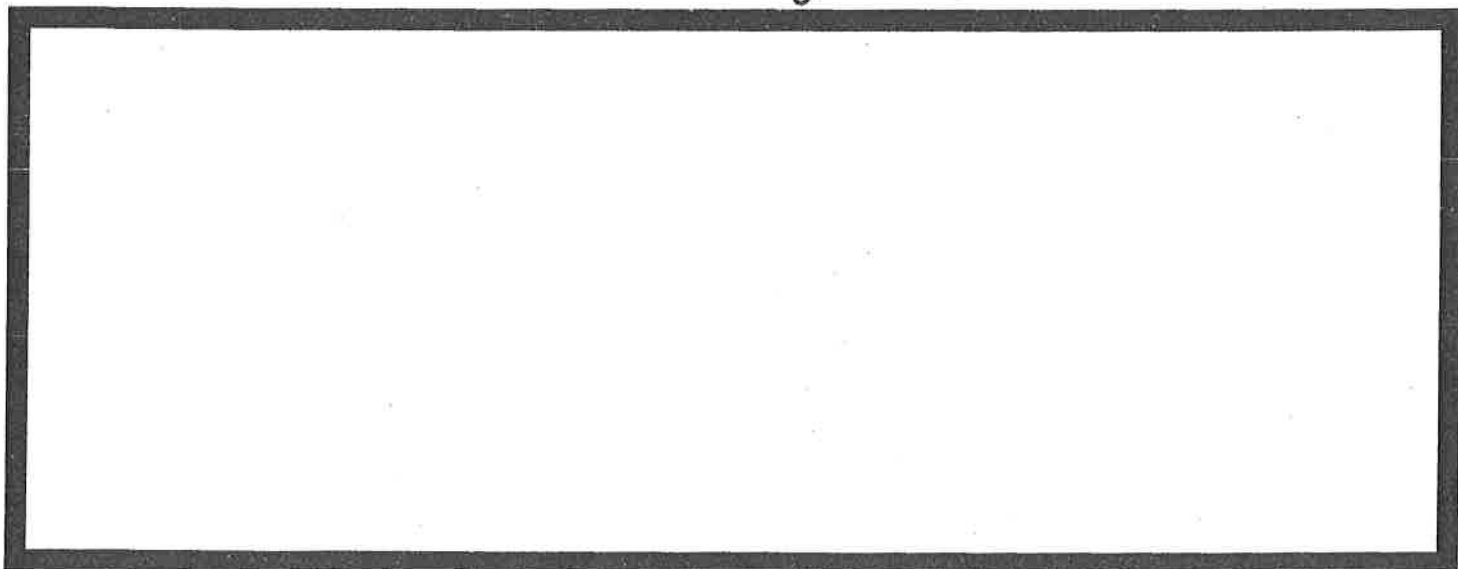
