

PUSD POLICY ON STUDENT ILLNESSES

Many parents have called the office asking what the policy is on student illnesses. For your information, below is the PUSD Policy on illnesses taken from their website at www.Pleasanton.k12.ca.us under Educational Services; Pupil Services – Health Services.

For the safety and protection of all students, teachers and staff, we ask that you keep your child home from school if they have any of the following symptoms: Common cold: Keep home during period of productive cough and yellow or green nasal discharge; Fever of 99.8 or above; Eyes that are red, swollen, crusting or draining, Untreated, draining ears or earache; Diarrhea; Childhood communicable disease-(please notify school); Nausea or vomiting; Head lice; Severe sore throat; Skin rashes/irritation.

If a student is at school with any of the above, the parent(s)/guardian(s) will be called to pick up their student. Under certain circumstances, the parent may be asked to consult a physician and to provide a written note from a doctor indicating that the student may return to school.
