

Curriculum Development

Continuing curriculum study and development are necessary if the district is to meet the needs of the children in its schools.

The curriculum director, reporting to the Superintendent or designee, will be responsible for directing curriculum studies and for providing leadership in curriculum improvement.

The Board expects the administration and teachers to work together in evaluating the education program and recommending additions and changes in courses, programs, and instructional approaches. All teachers have professional obligations to the school program beyond regular classroom duties, and these include work on curriculum committees. It is expected that teachers will play a role in curriculum development and make contributions to the work.

The Board will hear regular reports on the instructional programs and on the work of curriculum committees. New courses and programs will be recommended by the superintendent and adopted by the Board.
