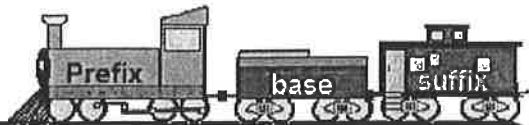

Prefixes: pre- re- mis-



A prefix is a word part that is added to the front of a base word to change the meaning of that word.

Examples:

The prefix **pre-** means "before."

pre + school = preschool (before school)

The prefix **re-** means "again."

re + make = remake (make again)

The prefix **mis-** means "bad or wrong."

mis + spell = misspell (spell wrong)

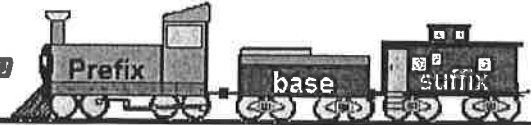

Prefixes: in- im- out-



A prefix is a word part that is added to the front of a base word to change the meaning of that word. A prefix may have more than one meaning.

Examples:

The prefixes *in-* and *im-* mean "inside" or "not"

The prefix *out-* means "outside" or "beyond"

in + take = intake (take inside)

im + mature = immature (not mature)

out + law = outlaw (outside the law)

out + run = outrun (run beyond)

Tip: Use *im-* (instead of *in-*) before base words beginning with *b*, *m*, or *p*.
