by Gelett Burgess

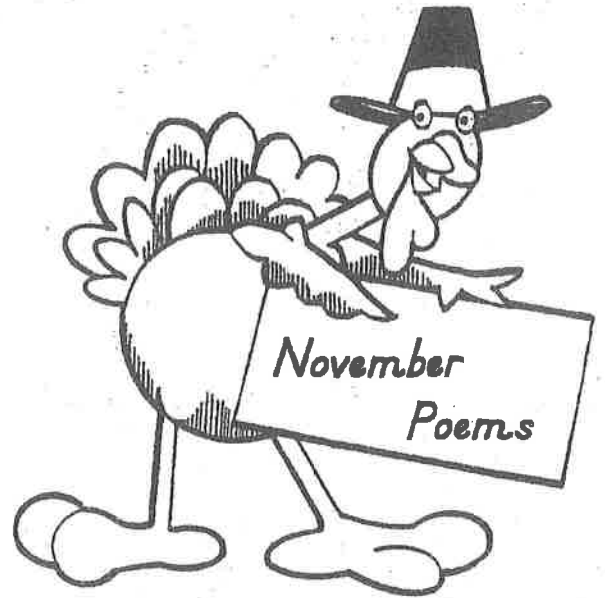
The Goops they lick their fingers;

The food should go!

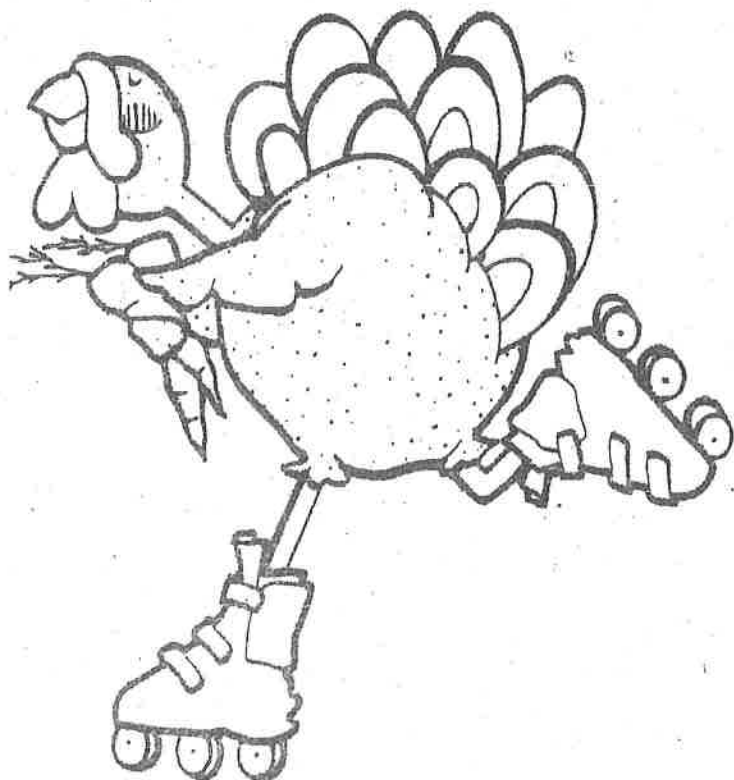
7. The Cupboard
