• Using any type of material available to you, create a mask for the Capulet ball. The assignment will be evaluated based on effort and creativity, and awards will be given for each of the following categories :

- Most original design
- Most colorful
- Most unique materials
- Most carefully done
- Wildest
- Funniest
- Design that best reflects a character from *Romeo and Juliet*

Materials

- Use any materials you have available. You might want to consider: cardboard, felt, fabric, construction paper, tissue paper, aluminum foil, crayons, markers, feathers, macaroni, fly-tying supplies. **Be creative!**
- You will need to supply your own materials.

Some Directions that Might Help

- Select an outline for your mask or design an outline of your own.

Basic outlines:

Design suggestions: animals, insects, flowers, geometric shapes, rock stars, moon, stars, planets, picture collages, etc., etc.

- Draw your mask on cardboard and cover the front with felt, construction paper, or another material of your choice. If you don't have any cardboard, cut several copies of your mask out of construction paper and glue the layers together for added strength.
- Decorate your mask.
- Punch holes in the sides and attach strings or use a stick that can be used to hold the mask.
