

## NHS SELECTION PROCEDURES

Below are the selection procedures as outlined in Article IX of the National Honor Society Constitution. Mrs. Deuer is the NHS adviser and will gladly accept questions regarding this procedure. Contact information is the following: 722-2227x2041

The selection procedure has been determined by the Faculty Council and is published in the student agenda, posted on the NHS website at the Goshen Local Schools web page, and posted in the NHS case at GHS.

1. Students' academic records are reviewed to determine scholastic eligibility. To be eligible, students must have a minimum **weighted 3.75 cumulative GPA** and have no expulsions, suspensions, or APP for the current school year. Students must be in GHS for **FOUR** academic classes per day. A student's attendance rate must be at 93% for the school year.
2. Students who are eligible scholastically are notified and told that for further consideration for selection to the NHS chapter, they must complete the Student Activity Information page. This is included in the information packet. **Candidates not interested in possible consideration for NHS should sign and return the enclosed waiver in the packet indicating as such.**
3. All faculty members are invited to make comments on candidates using a faculty evaluation sheet as distributed by the candidate. However, the actual selection must be made by the five appointed members of the Faculty Council. It is not permissible to take an entire faculty vote.
4. The Student Activity Information form, along with any other verifiable information about each candidate and his or her activities including but not limited to attendance and discipline records, should be reviewed by the Faculty Council. This form defines the candidate's leadership, service, and character and disciplinary and attendance record.
5. Selection: Candidates receiving a majority vote of the Faculty Council will be inducted into the chapter.
6. Notification: Students who are selected, and their parents, are notified of their selection and given information regarding the upcoming induction ceremony and the obligation of membership in NHS.
