Guidelines

- Choose either the style of Campbell or Rank
- Your title should be your **Hero's name** followed by "**A Campbellian/Rankian Tale**" which should inform me which style you are following
- Write the story in Chapter form
 - Each chapter should incorporate one of the Hero's journey elements
 - Title each chapter according to the element it demonstrates
 - Ex: Chapter 1, The Call to Adventure
- You must use all elements of either Rank or Campbell
 - You may put them in whatever order you like
- 12 pt font, TNR, Double Spaced, 1" margins
- Each page should contain a **maximum** of 3 chapters, that means 4 FULL pages, no more than 6.
- I expect some thought, creativity, and effort. Have fun with this one.
