COLUMBIA – BRAZORIA INDEPENDENT SCHOOL DISTRICT STUDENT RANDOM DRUG TESTING

CBISD requires drug testing of any student in grades 7-12 who chooses to participate in school sponsored extracurricular activities or requests a permit to park a vehicle on school property.

CBISD shall provide each parent and student a copy of the drug-testing policy and consent form prior to the student's participation in an affected activity or receipt of a parking permit.

Random tests shall be conducted on as many as ten dates throughout the school year.

A student who refuses to be tested when selected or who is determined to have tampered with a sample shall be deemed to have a positive test result and shall be subject to the appropriate consequences depending on previous positive test results, if any.

A student or parent may appeal a decision made under this policy in accordance with FNG (LOCAL). The student shall be ineligible for participation in extracurricular activities or reinstatement of parking privileges while the appeal is pending.

Benzodiazepines (Valium, Librium)

Methaqualone (Quaaludes)

Alcohol

Anabolic Steroids (performance enhancing drugs)
