## LoveWorks Academy Instructional Framework

- 1. We teach to Minnesota Standards and Benchmarks.
- 2. Standards apply to all students with high expectations for their success.
- 3. Teachers know how each lesson relates to a Standard/Benchmark progression.
- 4. Students know what they are learning, why they are learning it, and how it connects to them.
- 5. Planning begins with Standards/Benchmarks rather than materials.
- 6. Student tasks are engaging and clearly aligned to a Standard/Benchmark.
- 7. Students know how the teacher wants them to show what they've learned.
- 8. Students often evaluate their own work before the teacher does, using the same criteria.
- 9. Feedback to students is related to performance level on Standards/Benchmarks.
- 10. Student performance data are used to revise curriculum and instruction.
- 11. The assessment system includes summative tests for program evaluation and classroom assessments for individual student diagnosis and instruction.
- 12. Students have multiple opportunities to demonstrate achievement of Standards/ Benchmarks.
- 13. Teachers collaborate to create and analyze classroom lessons and assessments.
