Br. Patrick Honohan O.F.M. Cap.

Patrick Honohan was born September 16, 1905 in Cork, Ireland. After his Solemn Profession he came to the United States. In the 1940's he was assigned to the newly opened St Francis High School where he was cook for the community. Patrick was very diligent in his work. He was a prayerful and good community Friar. In his spare time he helped to keep the grounds nice and trim. His last assignment was at Old Mission Santa Ines Solvang. Along with being cook he took care of the sacristy, helped to keep the church clean and tidy and worked on the mission grounds. He was very prayerful and could always be seen in his spare time pacing by the front arches of the Old Mission praying his rosary. Patrick did not believe in wasting time. During his final years his health began to fail, yet faithful and hard working as he was, he continued with his duties until death overtook him, September 6, 1979. He lived to see the founding of the new Province of Our Lady of Angels, April 18, 1979. He is buried at San Lorenzo in Santa Ynez.
