## **Student Transportation Services**

School bus transportation for pupils to and from school shall be provided in accordance with a plan adopted by the Board. The plan shall define areas of residence wherein pupils will be eligible for transportation.

Reasonable temporary exceptions may be made to established routes and transportation areas when necessary by the superintendent or supervisor of transportation.

In accordance with State Statutes, the Board shall provide for transportation or maintenance, where necessary, for isolated students in the District.

Approval of isolation applications shall be done on an individual basis by the Board with acceptance or rejection being predicated by such factors as distance from where the parent resides to the school, safety and welfare of the child, and availability of bus transportation.\* The amount of maintenance allowance is at the discretion of the Board.\*\*

Pupils transported by regularly established bus routes are not eligible for isolation unless private transportation is necessary to take them to meet a bus.

\*Parents transporting children to school on their way to work are not eligible for mileage reimbursement.

\*\*Maintenance stipends will not be paid to parents who have business interests in the location of the temporary move.
