## Principles of the Magna Carta

Democratic Ideal	What does it say?	In your own words	Real World Example
<b>Rule of Law</b>	Government shall be carried out according to established laws, Both those who govern and those who are governed will be bound by these laws.		
<b>Limited Government</b>	Government should perform only the functions that people have given it the power to perform. Power is shared between the governed and those who govern.		
<b>Due Process of Law</b>	Government must act fairly and in accord* with established rules in all that it does and may not act arbitrarily.**		
<b>Individual Liberty</b>	Specific rights that belong to each person, such as life, liberty, and property, and cannot be taken away without due process of law.		
<b>Consent of the Governed</b>	Government is based on the will of the people who grant their approval through elections and other forms of civic participation.
