# What is 21F?

*21F is a state law designating each public school system in the state of Michigan to allow students in grades 5-12 the opportunity to enroll in up to two Michigan approved online courses per term with parent consent.*

# What will online learning look like at TK?

**\*You will be allowed to leave school grounds during your online learning hour.**

**For example:**

**3rd hour is your online learning experience.  
You may leave at 9:38 and return by 10:41.**

- \* You may use the library as a patron.**
- \* Tests/Exams that are locked must be taken at TKHS with Ms. Hubers. This includes midterms and finals.**



# What will online learning look like at TK? Cont.

\*Online Students are required to sign in or out of the building during their schedule online hour at the main office.



# What will online learning look like at TK? Cont.

- \*Students MAY NOT be in the school including the chill zone during their scheduled online class time.
- \*The online learning process will be reviewed each semester.



# Monitoring of grades?

- Students and Parents should monitor online course progress frequently.
- Students and Parents should utilize the TKHS Mentor when needed and appropriate.
- Students who are unsuccessful may have scheduled meetings with Mrs. Wegner as well as parents.
- Students who are unsuccessful may be required to stay on campus and report to a designated area for monitoring during online learning hour.

# Communication is Key!



- If there is a problem with coursework, grading, and/or assessments make sure you contact the MI Virtual Teacher as soon as possible.
- Parents will have to log in under the student's password in order to monitor progress.
- There is not a way to connect this to PowerSchool at this time.
