

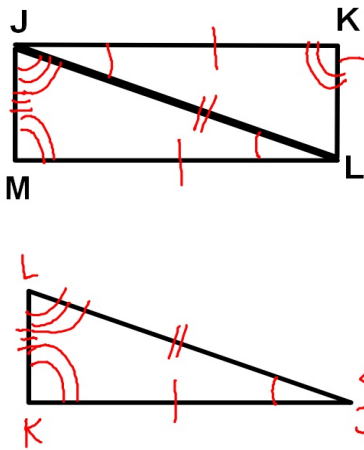
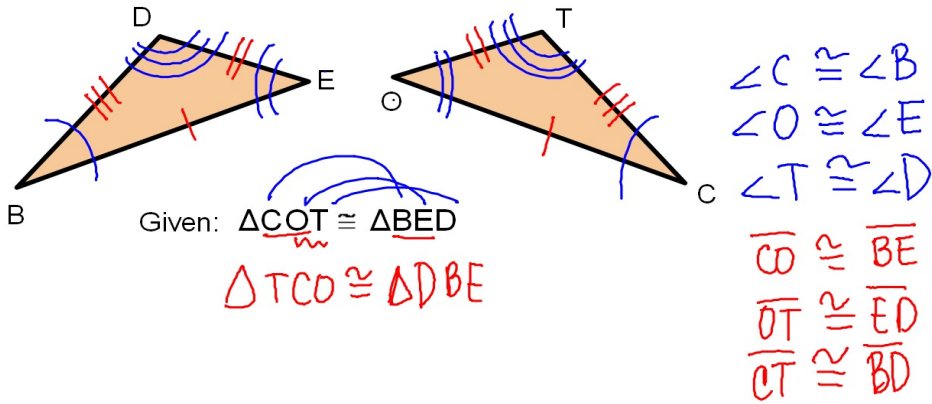
4-1 Congruent Triangles

Definition

Congruent triangles are two triangles in which all pairs of corresponding parts are congruent.
(\angle s + sides)



$\triangle JKL \cong \triangle LMJ$

$\overline{JK} \cong \overline{LM}$
 $\overline{JL} \cong \overline{LJ}$ reflexive
 $\overline{KL} \cong \overline{MJ}$
