

HELLO, MY NAME IS . . .

A new school year is just starting and you're probably seeing a lot of new faces. Now is a good time to introduce yourself, both to your teacher and to others in the class. Try a Bio Poem and you'll be off to a great start. The bio (short for biography) poem is a good way to tell who you really are. Just follow the format below:

- Line 1 Your first name only
- Line 2 Four positive adjectives that describe you
- Line 3 Sibling of, or son/daughter of
- Line 4 Lover of (three things, people or ideas)
- Line 5 Who feels (three things)
- Line 6 Who fears (three items)
- Line 7 Who would like to see (three items)
- Line 8 Resident of (your city, street or neighborhood)
- Line 9 Your last name only
