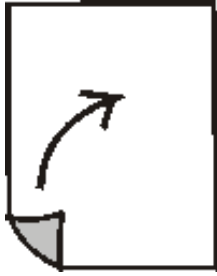
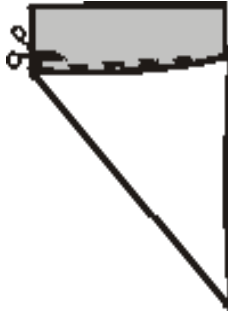


# How to Make a Figurative Language Cootie Catcher

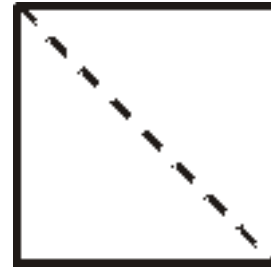
Follow these directions to make a cootie catcher..Then add the Figurative language types, definitions and examples and practice with a partner to help remember the definitions



1. Start with a rectangular sheet of paper. Fold the bottom of the paper to the side of the page to make a triangle.



2. Then cut off the flap above the triangle.



3. Now open the triangle and you'll have a square.



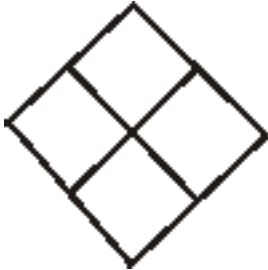
4. Fold one corner to the other corner diagonally.



5. Open paper.



6. Fold corners toward center of paper.



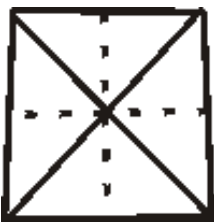
7. When all 4 corners are folded, your paper will look like this.



8. Flip your paper over so the folded sides are face down.



9. Again, fold corners toward center diagonally.



10. When all 4 corners are folded, your paper will look like this. You have eight right triangles.



11. On the same side, where the numbers are above, write the definitions for each type of figurative language



12. Hold the paper in front of you like a square. Fold it in half vertically and open it back up again.



13. Write each type of figurative language on a triangle

14. Now Decorate! Add color and designs to make it look cool!

15. Time to play. With a partner, open and close your cootie catcher and stop. Your partner should randomly choose a triangle. Read out loud the type of figurative language they have picked and have them give you an example of it. Now it's your turn. Trade off and keep score.
