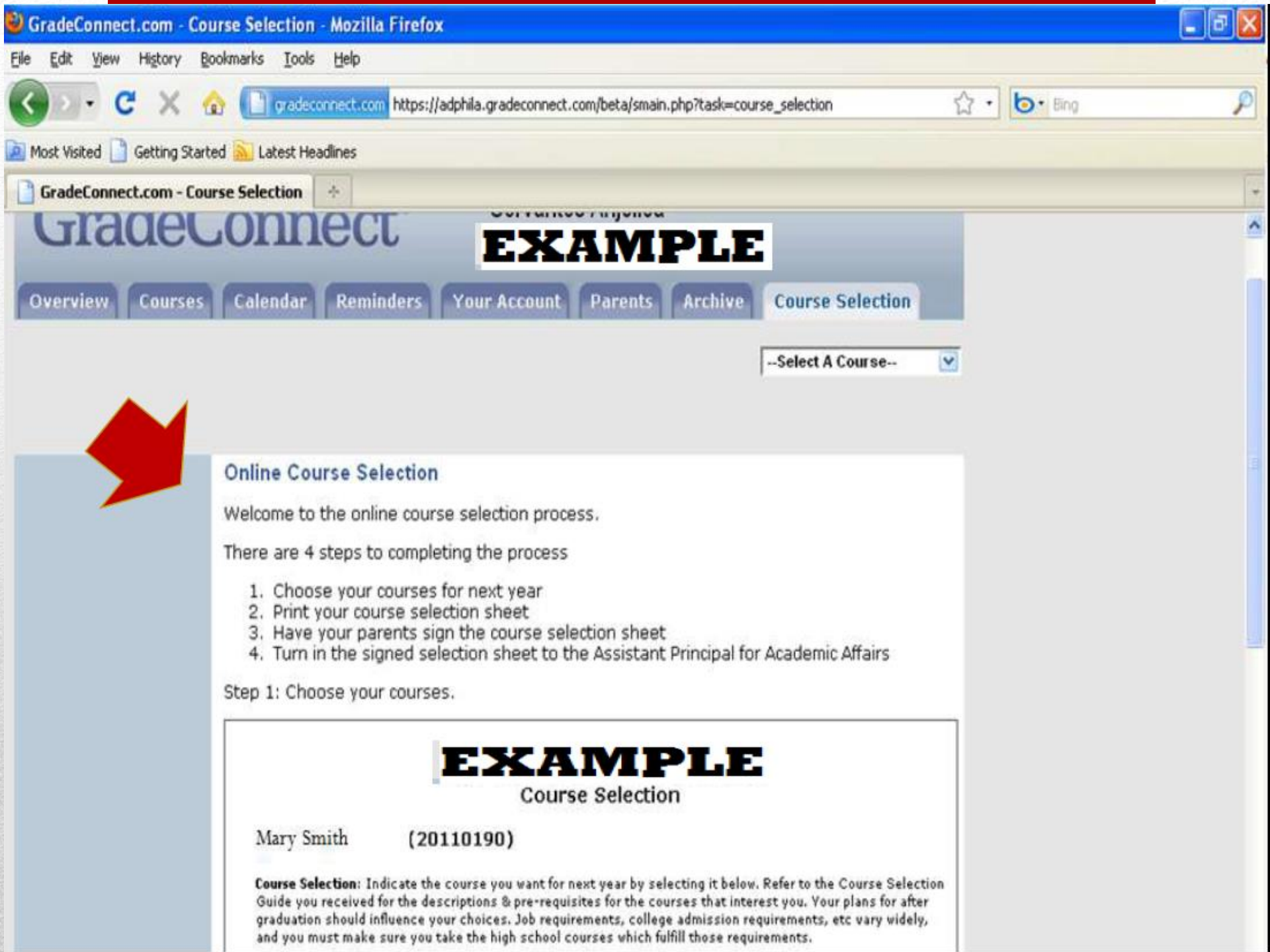

### Online Course Selection

Welcome to the online course selection process.

There are 4 steps to completing the process

1. Choose your courses for next year
2. Print your course selection sheet
3. Have your parents sign the course selection sheet
4. Turn in the signed selection sheet to the Assistant Principal for Academic Affairs

# Course Selection

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- Holy Family University will offer Holy Family courses here on campus at Archbishop Ryan to eligible seniors and juniors
- Can take one or two Holy Family courses for both high school and college credit
- These courses also become a part of an unofficial college transcript, meaning that they may satisfy college core requirements

# **Holy Family Courses**

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- Eligible students must carry a minimum of five Ryan courses.
  - For a student who carries five Ryan courses, that student must select two Holy Family courses, one each semester (Fall and Spring).
  - If a student carries six Ryan courses, that student may elect to take just one Holy Family course in the Fall but may also take an additional course in the Spring.

# **Holy Family Courses**

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- The cost per course to Ryan students is just \$200, plus the cost of books.
- Typically, a student taking college courses part time at a local college or university can pay as much as two thousand dollars per course
