Item 14.1: 14.1. Report and Discussion of the School Climate Transformation Grant Update

The Pleasanton Unified School District is the recipient of a School Climate Transformation Grant from the U.S. Department of Education Office of Safe and Healthy Students. Funds are dispersed over the course of five years and emphasize the implementation of multi-tiered systems of support for students with Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS). An update was provided on the implementation timeline, goals, and next year's focus of Tier One intervention strategies.

Outcome: This item was for discussion only; no action was taken.

Item 14.2: Report and Discussion of the Update on Expansion of Technology at the Middle Schools

In order to provide equity and greater access to the curriculum through the use of 21st century instructional technology supporting the implementation of the District Strategic Plan, the middle schools are proposing to expand the traditional Laptop Program to all students beginning with 6th grade during the 2015-16 school year. This presentation is designed to provide follow up to the previous presentation to the Board of Trustees shared during the January 27, 2015 meeting.

Item 14.3: Report, Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Legal Services for the Board

At the request of the Board President, discussion and possible action regarding legal services for the Board. The Board will discuss pros/cons and options for retaining an attorney to address Board-related questions.

Item 14.4: Report and Discussion of the First Reading of Board Policy and Administrative Regulation Series 6000, Instruction (Series 4 of 4)

Staff has reviewed current Board Policies (BP) and Administrative Regulations (AR), 6164.4, 6164.5, 6164.6, 6171, 6172.1, 6173, 6173.1, 6183, and 6190. Following the CSBA (California School Board Association) recommended Board Policies and Administrative Regulations, staff recommends adopting 6164.4, 6164.5, 6164.6, 6171, 6172.1, 6173, 6173.1. 6183, and 6190. The BP's and AR's are being presented for First Reading.
