



# NHS Chapter Requirements

- Dues are \$15 if paid before January 16<sup>th</sup> and \$20 if paid after January 16<sup>th</sup>. Dues of \$15 will be due in following years before the last day of the first semester and \$20 dollars for dues paid in the second semester.
- 20 individual community service hours will be completed and are due the last day of school in a school year. The period runs from June–May and will start over the following June. A member who has not completed their hours will be issued a notice of removal letter and must make up the deficient hours over the summer over the summer and turn them in the first week of the coming school year in order to avoid a dismissal–hearing with the faculty council. These hours will not be included in the coming years tally if they are used as make–up hours.
- 9 group community service hours will be completed and are due the last day of school in a school year. The period runs from June–May and will start over the following June. A member who has not completed their hours will be issued a notice of removal letter and must make up the deficient hours over the summer over the summer and turn them in the first week of the coming school year in order to avoid a dismissal–hearing with the faculty council. These hours will not be included in the coming years tally if they are used as make–up hours.
- Members are required to attend inductions of new members. If a member is unable to attend they must make up the absence by donating 2 dozen



cookies for the reception following induction or pay a \$5 penalty to the treasurer. Extreme circumstances will be taken into account and exceptions will be voted on by the Executive Committee as outlined in the constitution.

- Members must regularly attend NHS meetings. Meetings will be held the 2<sup>nd</sup> Wednesday of each month at 4:10 pm in Mrs. Skelton's Classroom (room 206).
- Members who miss more than half of the meetings called within a school year will be penalized and be eligible for a dismissal letter and hearing with the faculty council.
- Members who are unable to maintain an 85 or 3.5 cumulative GPA may be issued a notice of dismissal and have 1 semester to raise the cumulative GPA. If the member is unable to maintain the GPA afterward there will be a faculty council hearing.
- All members must be familiar with the Pleasanton High School Honor Society Constitution.
- All members must conduct themselves in behaviors befitting of an NHS member.
