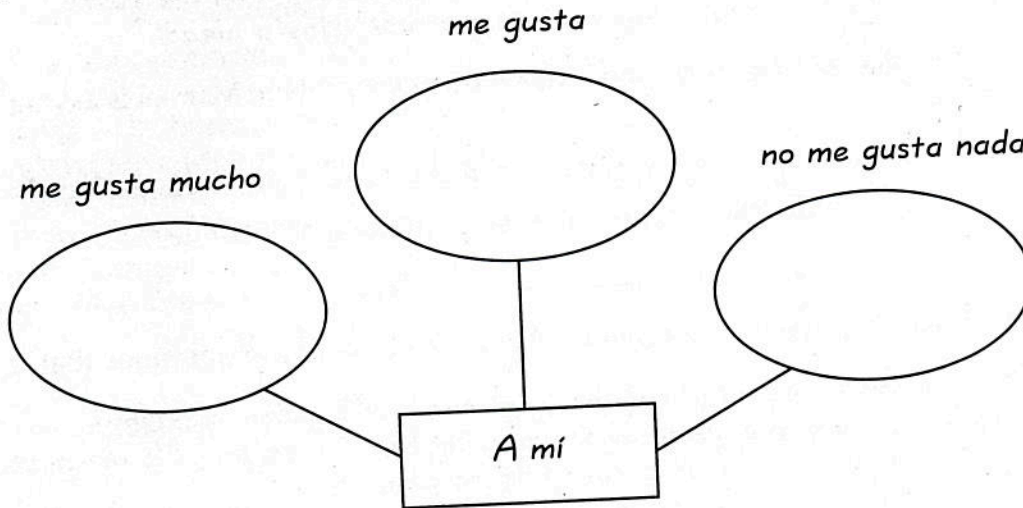


Presentación oral (p. 43)
