For every source, you should have a note card.

Minimum sources = 6

Minimum note cards = 6

Type of Source: website, book, article, journal

Bibliographic Information: Huxley, Aldous. *Brave New World*. New York: Harper Perennial Modern Classics, 2006. Print.

Source #: #2

- Use the MLA tab
- Choose the appropriate source type tab
- Use the Manual entry tab
- Fill in the blanks by doing a scavenger hunt (look for the information) with your sources
- Click “Make Citation” tab
- Copy citation from Citation Machine
- Open a word document
- Paste onto word document
- When finished with ALL sources, make sure sources are in alphabetical (ABC) order by the author’s last name or article title or website title
- Save document as Works Cited file
- Print document
- Cut each source entry and paste onto note card

If you are using, EbscoHost:

- Make sure to click on the “cite” tab
- Scroll down to MLA citation
- Copy citation
- Paste onto word document
