Theme: *The 3 Eras of the San Gabriel Valley*
Gabrielino, Spanish Mission, Rancho
(pre-1771) (1771-1821) (1821-1848)

Mural will be applied on one part of the Ramona Museum's Main Hall. (Approximately 8 ½ ft tall by 28 ft wide.). It will become the background for our new Gabrielino Exhibit. A Gabrielino dwelling (Tongva Ki) in front of the wall mural must be incorporated into your design.

The winning design will get a \$300 award. The winner's name will be included on the mural. The artist/artistic team will get recognition for their work. The Ramona Museum Committee will present the award at a school assembly. Also, an adult will be needed for artistic oversight of the project. Ramona Museum will provide the paint and supplies for the participants.

A **San Gabriel Mission High School Staff** will choose the top 3 semi-finalist designs.
A **Ramona Museum Committee** will choose the finalist out of the 3 semi-finalist designs.

THREE WALL PANELS (Museum's actual wall dimensions are 8 ½ feet by 28 feet)

Panel 1...San Gabriel Valley ***pre-Mission*** time period.

Wall: 8 ½ ft H, 8 ft W

---What the early Spanish Explorers would have seen when they first saw a Gabriolino settlement, including the plan for an indigenous dwelling.

Panel 2...San Gabriel Valley ***Mission*** time period.

Wall: 8 ½ ft H, 11 ft W

---A scene representing a Mission settlement.

Panel 3...San Gabriel Valley ***Mexican*** time period up to 1848.

Wall: 8 ½ ft H, 9 ft W

---A scene representing California right before it becomes a state.

STUDENT DESIGN

All historical representations should be accurate and should be researched.

Student will paint on 18 x 24 inch art paper/board (three separate paintings) using acrylics.

Ramona Museum will provide the art supplies for the student's paintings.

Ramona Museum will enlarge the student's paintings to make the mural.

Ramona Museum will apply the mural to the Museum wall.
