BY ATTENDING THIS DANCE, FVHS STUDENTS ARE AGREEING TO REMAIN TOBACCO, DRUG AND ALCOHOL FREE AND ACKNOWLEDGE THAT FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES CAN RESULT IN CONSEQUENCES WHICH MAY INCLUDE INELIGIBILITY FOR CO-CURRICULAR AND EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES INCLUDING ATHLETICS, SENIOR ACTIVITIES AND POSSIBLY, COMMENCEMENT EXERCISES AS WELL AS SUSPENSION AND POSSIBLE EXPULSION.

FVHS students understand that dances are school-related events and all school rules apply. Students agree to abide by the dance behavior rules set forth in this Code Of Conduct, including the school dress code and any other school rules for dances during the 2014 – 2015 academic year.

- 1. **Students may be checked** for illegal, unauthorized or controlled substance prior to entry to the dance area. Security may conduct "pat downs" and purse searches. Students may be subject to a breathalyzer test before entering the dance. Students who refuse to comply with searching can be denied entry.
- 2. **Dance Etiquette** (applies on and off the dance floor): Lewd and lascivious dancing such as "freaking" can result in a student being asked to leave the event and may make him or her ineligible to attend future dances for the duration of the school year. Parents may be notified. Dancing guidelines include, but are not limited to:
 - No straddling legs
- No bending over and touching the floor
- No front to back touching
- No touching of breasts, buttocks or genitals
- No "making out" (no overt and/or prolonged public displays of affection)
- Mosh Pits are not allowed
- Hands on waists or shoulders only
- 3. The following items are not permitted at school sponsored dances and may be confiscated:
