

# Create a Class Passport

## Assignment

On the large index card given to you, paste a recent, recognizable picture of yourself (a head shot if possible). The picture should fit within the boundaries of 1/4 of the index card. If the picture is too large, trim it so it will fit, or use another! *Please don't go and spend money to have a picture taken, see if you can find a picture that you would be willing give away for this purpose, or make a copy of your Student ID picture..*

**Please use a picture that will help me recognize you (i.e. recent, no sun-glasses, silly-faces, hats shading your face etc...).** Paste the picture in the top left corner of the card.

**On the rest of the FRONT of the card include the following information...**

- Your College (Leave this blank for now...this will be filled in when you are assigned to a University Team)
- Your Legal Name - First Last (print in large letters) - This should be the name that would appear on my class role.
- Nickname (or what you want me to call you if different from your first name above)
- Your email address
- Your local or cell phone #
- Your favorite subject
- Grade
- Your hobbies/interests

**On the BACK of the passport**

- Tell me about your favorite book.
- Take the following brief survey. Then cut it out and glue it onto the back of your card. Tally up your total points and write the total in the bottom right corner of the back of your passport.

Indicate by giving yourself the following point values for each of the following questions - "5" if you strongly agree, "4" if you agree, "3" if you are neutral, "2" if you disagree, and "1" if you strongly disagree with the statement below.

Please write your number each individual statement on the back of the card. Then, tally these points and write the TOTAL in the front side lower left corner of your class passport.

- 2) \_\_\_ I am confident in my ability to understand literature concepts.
- 3) \_\_\_ I generally like to take a leadership role in group discussions.
