

JISD Transportation Write up Consequences

Bus Write up Consequences

1st write up---copy of write up sent to parent and to student's school. In addition, a letter is sent to the parents explaining that the next write up will result in bus riding suspension

2nd write up---Student is suspended for 1 school day

3rd write up---Student is suspended for 3 school days

4th write up---Student is suspended for 5 school days

5th Write up---Student is suspended for 7 school days

6th Write up—Student is suspended for 20 school days

7th Write up---Student is suspended for rest of the school year

If a Severe misbehavior occurs, the write up level goes to the 6th level or 7th level depending upon the severity of the offence. A Severe Clause infraction include (but are not limited to): assault, bullying, fighting, drugs, weapons, excessive displays of public affection, sexual harassment, failure to give proper name, throwing items out bus windows, and placing limbs/head out of bus window.

Write ups do not "zero out" at the beginning of the second semester. The write up count will begin at the first of school and continue until the end of school.

All students above the Elementary grade who engage in a fight on the Bus will be suspended for the remainder of the semester. Elementary grade students who are 10 years of age or older may be suspended for the remainder of the semester. Elementary grade students who are younger than 10 years of age who engage in a fight on the Bus will be suspended from the Bus in accordance to the severity of the infraction as determined by the Transportation Director or his designee.

During a Bus suspension, the Student will not be allowed to ride any JISD Bus.
