

LA3: Accessing the Online Student Edition

Step 1: Go to <http://www.glencoe.com/> Choose California & Literature from the two drop-down menus at the top. Click Student/Parent. Click ENTER.

Step 2: Click Glencoe Literature: California Treasures © 2010

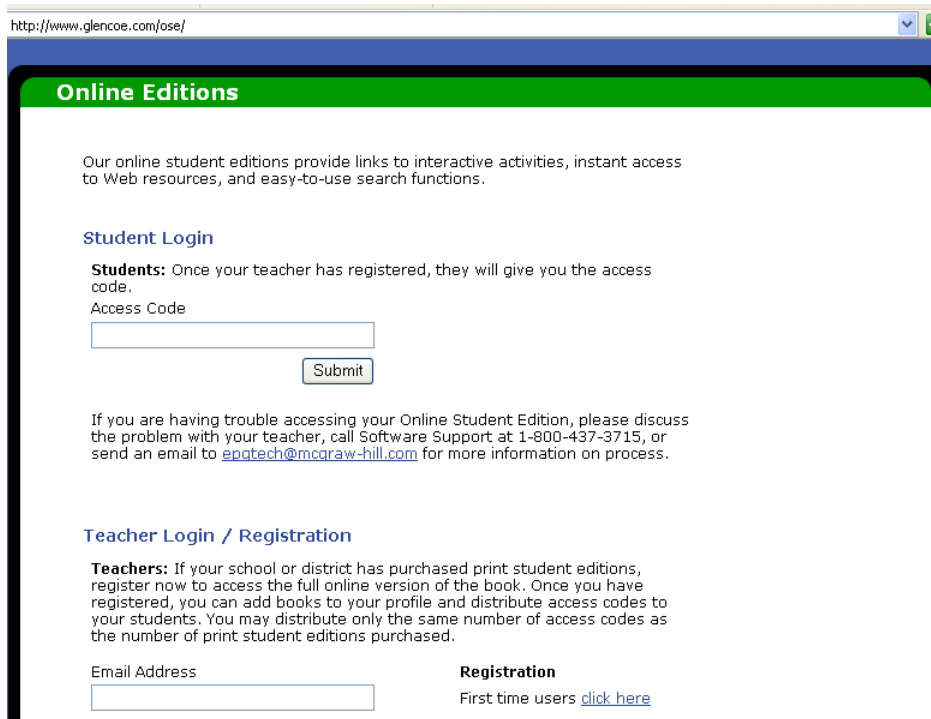
Step 4: Click Student/Parent Center. Click ENTER.
