Lesson 9: Being Responsible, Respectful, and Ready in the Classroom/ Using An Electronic Communication Device

Time: 25-minute lesson

Purpose of the Lesson/ Why Is It Important?

“Today we are going to talk about the policy of electronic communication devices according to the Tift County Schools 2013-2014 Code of Conduct.”

Introduction/Anticipatory Set

1. Discuss the meaning of electronic communication device. According to the Code of Conduct, electronic communication device shall mean a cellular or mobile phone, pager, I-phone, Blackberry, or ANY other device designed for the purpose or having the capacity for personal electronic communication.

Teacher Modeling/Examples

Teacher will display the flipchart or PowerPoint titled “Electronic Communication Devices”

Practice:

Complete the Ticket out the Door on Electronic Communication Devices. One of the tickets has specific questions. The other is left blank....if you choose to ask different questions.

Students may share their answers.

Follow Up/Booster Activities

Persuasive Essay:

Should students be allowed to use their electronic device at appropriate times during the school day? Why or why not?
