



PUSD CALENDAR ADVISORY COMMITTEE: PARENT MEMBER APPLICATION

The Pleasanton Unified School District plans to convene a committee of parents, staff, and students to explore possible calendar options for the 2016-17 school year and beyond. In addition to the current traditional calendar format, the committee will discuss and explore other alternative school calendar options, - *including options that would end the first semester before the start of the Winter Break*. This would be in order to provide a true break for students free of assignments and studying for exams.

One of the primary tasks of the committee will be to examine calendar options and survey instruments from other school districts in order to provide input for developing PUSD online surveys. The PUSD online surveys would be used to gather calendar-related input from Pleasanton parents, community members, staff, and students. The committee would then analyze and discuss the input received and forward recommended calendar options to the district for further negotiation and possible school board approval.

It is anticipated that the committee would meet for about 2 hours in the late afternoon or early evening once in May and again in June this school year, and then resume monthly meetings in September as school begins again for the 2015-16 school year.

Please complete and submit this application by Wednesday, May 6 if you would be interested in being considered to serve as a member of this Calendar Advisory Committee. We are looking to have six parents on the committee: two with at least one child at the elementary school level; two with at least one child at the middle school level; and two with at least one child at the high school level. The school board will review all applications submitted by the deadline. You will then receive an email from the district regarding the status of your application.
