Presbyterian Pan American School is a Christian college preparatory school that educates and empowers young adults for leadership in the global community. It is also one of the seven racial/ethnic mission schools of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). For one hundred years Pan American has remained committed to offering an academic program in an atmosphere of excellence and faith.

The campus is located on a 670-acre working ranch south of Kingsville, Texas and has a current enrollment of approximately 160 students from seven countries throughout the world. It is a four-year fully accredited high school with an additional faith-based curriculum. Every May 100% of its graduates are accepted into colleges or universities in their home countries or the United States. The school credits its success to a three-part emphasis on academics, mandatory work program and Christian leadership development.

Pan American is able to provide generous financial assistance to 92% of their students this year through gifts from churches and individuals to the school's Scholarship Fund. Their students are provided a safe, family-oriented environment in which to live and learn. When our church supports Presbyterian Pan American School, we are investing in the future leadership of the church, and we are giving these young people from across the globe opportunities for a brighter future in service to Christ.
