The Civic Orchestra of Minneapolis will be appearing at Aurora Charter School. The event is free and open to all.

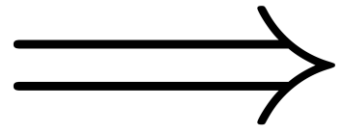
When: Tuesday evening, May 19

AURORA CHARTER SCHOOL STUDENTS TO SHARE CONCERT WITH CIVIC ORCHESTRA OF MINNEAPOLIS

Will the flute have the melody? Will it be the violins? Students at Aurora Charter School in South Minneapolis are wondering what instruments will accompany their choir as they sing *Cielito Lindo*. Soon they will find out. Led by music teacher Luana Mitchell, the children will be accompanied by the Civic Orchestra of Minneapolis as part of an evening concert at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 19th.

The singers from Aurora Charter School are in grades two through six. The Civic Orchestra of Minneapolis, conducted by Cary John Franklin, will be introducing some selections from the movie *Frozen* including the hit song, *Let It Go*.

Also on the program will be Argentine composer Alberto Ginastera's *Estancia: Four Dances* from his ballet and Mozart's *Overture to the Marriage of Figaro*. Due to limited space the 7:00 p.m. concert will be open only to families of the school. A host will translate for the Spanish-speaking students, family and community audience members.
