This program provides qualified Juniors and Seniors a concurrent enrollment here at FHA, and college credit-bearing courses at St. John's University—transferrable to many other colleges. Specific FHA courses approved for CAP include English 12, Religious Studies 12, Italian 4, Spanish 4, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, and Anatomy and Physiology. Eligible students may take up to 9 credits a semester. Eligibility criteria for a Senior is a minimum score of 500/500 in Critical Reading/Math on the SAT, or a 21 on the ACT, and a cumulative average of 80 in the 5 major subjects; for Juniors, a score of 50/50 Critical Reading/Math on the PSAT, and a cumulative average of 85 in the 5 major subjects.
