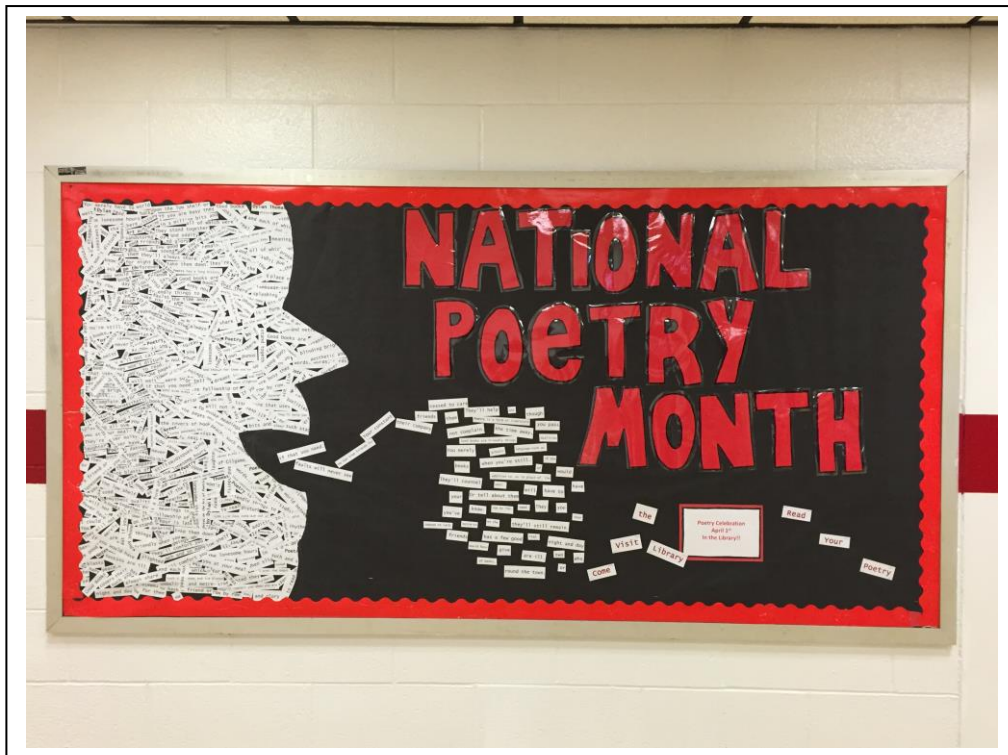
[NHS Helps North Haledon Celebrate Easter](#)
