Positively Tenor Award

Criteria:

- 90% attendance
- No referrals to the office
- Punctual
- Positive role model and leader in class/school environment
- Must be enrolled for at least two terms
- A written explanation for your nomination needs to be attached to the ballot
- Positively engages in class and school environment
- Grade Point Average of 3.0 for the term

Student of the Semester Award (Academic)

Criteria:

- 90% attendance
- No referrals to the office
- Positive role model in school
- Positive participation in class
- Turns in assignments in a timely manner
- Arrives to class on time
- Grade Point Average of 3.0 or above

Most Improved Student of the Semester

Criteria:

- Increase in overall attendance or maintaining 85% or higher overall attendance
- Minimal referrals to the office
- Improved behavior in school and class
- Increased class participation
- Increase in handing in assignments on time

Criteria:

- No referrals to the office

- Demonstrates kindness for all

- Minimal referrals to the office
- Participates in school activities
- Consistently shows enthusiasm at school events and activities
- Promotes school activities and spirit in others

Criteria:

- 90% attendance overall
- Minimal referrals to the office
- Participates in school-wide activities
- Willing to help others
- Shows trustworthiness and maturity
- Follows through on projects and tasks
- Contributes ideas and efforts to improve classrooms and the school

Leadership Award

Criteria:

- 90% attendance overall
- No referrals to the office
- Leads in a positive way
- Willing to serve others
- Contributes ideas and efforts to improve classrooms and the school
- Takes initiative in classroom and school wide activities
- Encourages others in a positive way
