



Internet Political Quizzes Assignment -- Where do you fall on the Political Spectrum??



ASSIGNMENT DIRECTIONS:

- (1) Get online (if you do not have access to the Internet at home, make arrangements to use the computers in the library, minilab, or classroom outside of class hours)
- (2) Proceed to www.politicalcompass.org
- (3) On the left side of the web page in the green column, you will see a blue link that reads "Take the test" (it is the second link). Click on that.
- (4) Answer the questions on all six pages of the test, and then click on the button that reads "Now let's see where you stand."
- (5) A page will appear that reads "About the Political Compass." Scroll down until you see the heading that reads "Your Political Compass" with a graph underneath it.
- (6) Click on the blue link below your graph that reads, "Show graph on a separate page for printing."
- (7) Once you are redirected to the new graph, print your results
- (8) Then proceed to typology.people-press.org/typology
- (9) Choose the option for each of the "Where Do You Fit?" questions that best represents your view on that particular issue. Then click "Calculate My Results"
- (10) Print out your results (you do not need to print the portion that reiterates your responses, just the section that identifies and explains your category).
- (11) Bring the results of both exams into class
- (12) SINCE YOU'RE ONLINE ANYWAY, DO ONE MORE FUN THING: proceed to www.selectsmart.com/president (if it's not working, just skip this step! 😊)
- (13) Take the quiz – make sure to indicate both your issue position AND the level of importance! Then click "Show My Results" and print out the results!
- (14) See which presidential candidates most and least match your positions! Any surprises?
