Board Actions

The Board:

- Approved the Second Interim Financial Statement for the fiscal year 2012-13. The Board President certified that this district will meet its financial obligations for the current fiscal year and subsequent two fiscal years
- Approved a resolution honoring the Huntington Beach Adult School during Adult Education Week
- Approved a resolution in support of Adult Education
- Adopted Board Policy 1312.3 expanding the Uniform Complaint Procedure to include complaints involving discrimination, harassment, intimidation or bullying

Presentations to the Board

- Assistant Superintendent of Business, Carrie Delgado, presented a status report on the fiscal year 2012-13 Second Interim Report and the district's financial condition.
- Steve Curiel, Principal of the Huntington Beach Adult School, presented "The Twilight" program, a collaborative program with other organizations, which provides educational services to more than 300 children and parents in the community.
