

Questions Concerning Financial Assistance and Scholarships

1. I currently receive financial assistance through BLOCS and/or TAP. Will these assistance awards follow me to Ryan?

These financial assistance awards are made annually by these organizations. Each year families must reapply for the upcoming academic year. Applications for both BLOCS (will be available after February 6th) and TAP are available on the home page of our website.

2. I currently receive financial assistance through the EITC program. Will this assistance award follow me to Ryan?

Sometimes. Usually the EITC awards are specific to the school. What that means is that the donor has provided the contribution to a specific school and the school has passed along the award to the student. It will be the donor's decision as to whether the award will be able to follow the student to his or her new school. You should contact your current school's President's Office to obtain further information.

3. I receive financial assistance through my school's alumni, or other organization. Will my assistance follow me to Ryan?

This question should be addressed to your school's alumni or other organization, which ever is providing the award. In the past, some alumni and other organizations have had their assistance awards follow the student to their new school.

4. Can I apply for the Ryan Alumni Tuition Assistance Program?

Yes. **All students** who will be attending Archbishop Ryan High School in the upcoming academic year are eligible to apply for the Ryan Alumni Tuition Assistance Program. Each student applying should also apply for TAP. Awards are made based on need. Applications may be downloaded from the home page of our website.

5. I currently receive an academic scholarship funded by my high school. Will my scholarship follow me to Ryan?

Yes! Students who have received an academic scholarship funded by their high school will have their scholarship honored at Ryan.

6. I currently receive an academic scholarship from an outside source such as Knights of Columbus, AOH, etc. Will my scholarship follow me to Ryan?

The organization awarding the scholarship will make that decision. In the past most organizations have permitted the scholarship to follow the student. You should contact the organization.
